1- EVOO Clever Tip — Improve the appearance of nails and cuticles.

Throughout history, well-manicured nails were a symbol of refinement, culture and civilization—distinguishing the commoner from the aristocrat. Olive oil applied to one's nails and cuticles will create a healthy glow and generally improve the overall appearance of both fingernails and cuticles. The following olive oil treatment is based on an old Egyptian recipe, possibly even from Cleopatra, who certainly knew how to take care of her body, her kingdom, and also her nails.

Nail and Cuticle Treatment:

- Mix 1 tablespoon of EVOO, 1 teaspoon of honey, and 1 ½ teaspoons of sea salt.
- Massage a small amount into your nails and cuticles.
- Wipe off any excess with a clean cloth and lightly buff.
- End the treatment with a few drops of EVOO massaged onto your hands

2- EVOO Factoid — Higher organic scores

Olives need very little water, and can search it out at great distances from the tree. Olive trees have an almost titanic resistance, a vital force that renders them nearly immortal. Despite the near 10 degree winters and burning summers, despite truncations, they continue to grow, proud and strong reaching towards the sky, bearing fruit that nourishes and heals inspires and amazes. Temperate climactic conditions, characterized by warm dry summers and rainy winters, favor plentiful harvests; stone, drought, silence, and solitude are the ideal habitat for the majestic olive tree. Olive trees planted near the sea can produce up to 20 times more fruit than those planted inland, in mountainous areas like Calabria. It is in these geographic areas that the olive trees' habitat is pushed to the extreme; if the conditions were just a little more severe, the trees would not survive. Extravirgin oils produced from these trees have higher organic scores.

3- Calabrian Recipe –

Thick maize porridge (polenta) served with sausages and beans

Ingredients: 400 grams of maize flour, pork sausages, white beans and extra virgin olive oil.



Procedure: Boil half liter of salted water, add the maize flour and mix very well. Sauté the sausage and the beans in EVOO in a frying pan. When the thick maize porridge is ready, pour it on a large plate adding the sausages, the beans and drizzle some EVOO to taste on top ...then serve. Mangia!
